BG(NS) Ravinder Singh is currently the Deputy Secretary (Technology) of the Ministry of Defence.

BG(NS) Ravinder joined the Singapore Armed Forces in 1982. He was awarded the SAF Overseas Training Award in 1983 and graduated with a Bachelor of Arts, Engineering (First Class Honours) from the University of Oxford. He was the Chief-of-Staff (Joint Staff), Singapore Armed Forces before assuming his current appointment as Deputy Secretary (Technology).
